President of Pirelli & C. Real Estate S.p.A..

Born in Milan in 1948.

He earned a degree in Economics from the University of Milan in 1971.

In the early 1970's he began his career in the family business, primarily in the sector of maritime shipping.

In 1986 he joined the Pirelli Group. In 1992 he became Director of Operations.

From December 1996 to September 2001, he was President of "Il Sole 24 Ore" and since 2005 he has been a member of the Board of Directors of "Teatro alla Scala".

From September 2001 to September 2006 he served as President of Telecom Italia S.p.A..

Currently he is President of Pirelli & C. S.p.A., Pirelli & C. Real Estate S.p.A. and Pirelli Tyre S.p.A..

He is also the President of CAMFIN, the majority shareholder of Pirelli & C. SpA.

He is Chairman of the Silvio Tronchetti Provera Foundation, whose objective is to promote scientific research and technology in Italy.

He is Vice President of Confindustria.

He is a member of the Oversight Committee of Mediobanca – Banca di Credito Finanziario S.p.A., a member of the board of directors of Università Commerciale Luigi Bocconi and of F.C. Internazionale Milano S.p.A..

He is the Italian President of the Council for Relations between Italy and the United States and is part of the Italian Group of the Trilateral Commission.

He is on the management committee of Assonime, on the International Advisory Board of Allianz and on the International Council of J.P. Morgan.
